Turkish Airlines COVID-19 Protocols

All passengers will be required to have a printed negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test taken at most 72 hours before departure of the last direct flight to Egypt. The test must be based on a nasal or oral swab. The test result must have a stamp of the issuing laboratory or a QR code.

- You will NOT be allowed entry into Egypt without proof of this test.
- The RT-PCR certificate must be an original paper certificate (Copy is not allowed).
- ID Now / PCR-NAA/ Antigen/IGg-IGm) tests are **NOT** acceptable by Egyptian authority.

Masks Permitted on Flights

In accordance with the airline travel regulations, passengers are required to wear either surgical masks or (FFP) face masks without valves. Make sure you bring extra masks to last you the duration of your journey. Surgical rated disposable masks, FFP, or N95 masks **WITHOUT VALVES** are the only masks allowed on board.



Masks NOT Permitted on Flights

In accordance with the civil aviation regulations, (FFP) face masks with valves, face shields, scarves, shawls and cloth face masks are not allowed on board. We would like to remind you that passengers cannot fly with these masks. *Please note that this includes handmade CLOTH masks.



Hygiene Measures

- Wear your **mask** all the time during your trip. When you remove your mask for security control, you can keep it **in a sealed bag**. When you need to remove your mask temporarily for eating or drinking, **put it in a sealed bag**.
- Bring extra masks in a plastic baggie and change masks **every four hours**.
- Do not hold the objects you carry such as passports, tickets and pens close to your mouth.
- Don't forget to wash your hands frequently with soap for **at least 20 seconds**.
- Avoid touching your face and mouth with your hands.
- At the airport, **if you feel unwell or have symptoms**, inform the authorities for your and other passengers' health.
